



Ronald A. Sherman

January 10, 1950 - November 4, 2017

Ronald A. Sherman, age 67 of Claysville, passed away on Saturday, November 4, 2017 at Ohio Valley Medical Center after he and his wife were involved in an auto accident. Ronald was born on January 10, 1950 in Cambridge, a son of the late John "Doc" Sherman and June (Ford) Sherman. Mr. Sherman was a 1967 graduate of Meadowbrook High School. He then joined the U.S. Navy and served over 20 years before retiring as a machinery repairman First Class. In 1985 he received the Navy Achievement Medal for his efforts in fighting a fire and evacuating all personnel on another ship in Guantanamo Bay. After retiring from the Navy, Ron went to work for Cambridge Tool and Die as a toolmaker. He was a member of the Masonic Lodge Guernsey #66, Scottish Rite and the Shriners.

Ron leaves behind: his wife of 47 years, Alaine A. (MacAlister) Sherman, they were married on May 9, 1970; a daughter Amber (Jim) Racchini of Indiana, PA and a son Sean Sherman of Claysville; two grandchildren, Chloe Sherman and Lucas Racchini; five sisters, Tammy K. Fish, Martha Redden, Debra Sherman, Elizabeth Stobart and Dora Lucey; a brother Scott (Karen) Sherman and many nieces and nephews.

Ron is preceded in death by: a brother David Lee Sherman; and his grandparents, Helen and Raymond Ford.

Visitation will be held at Buffalo Presbyterian Church in Cumberland on Saturday November 18, 2017 from 11 am to 1 pm with a service held at 1 pm. Pastor Jim Gibson will officiate the service with burial to follow in Cumberland
