Ruth Knowles Bennett 91, of Lebanon, formerly Cambridge died Wednesday, March 3, 2010 at her residence. Born April 12, 1918 to William and Lenora Fowl Knowles, Ruth's family immigrated from England and she was their first child born in the United States. Ruth graduated from Miami University with a Bachelors degree in Education and taught in the Cambridge, OH school district for 10 years, retiring in the early 1980's. She had been a resident of Lebanon for 19 years and was an active member of Lebanon Presbyterian Church, Countryside YMCA and former member of Lebanon Garden Club. She was also a longtime volunteer for the American Red Cross while living in Cambridge.

Ruth was preceded in death by her parents, husband, Robert C. Bennett, Jr., infant daughter, Susan Jane Bennett and three brothers, Tom, Frank and Roy Knowles. Survivors include her son, Rob Bennett Trish of Lebanon, daughter, Nancy Bentz Doug of Maineville, and 4 grandchildren, Robb Bennett, Susan Bentz, Laura Bentz and Erik Bentz.
