Ruth E. (White) Rose, age 93 of Cambridge, passed away on Friday, October 6, 2017 at the Cambridge Place. She was born on February 1, 1924 in Caldwell, a daughter of the late Harry E. White and Millicent (Spillman) White. Mrs. Rose was a 1942 graduate of Brown High School. She then went on to Muskingum College for four years before becoming a music teacher and former elementary music coordinator for Coshocton City Schools. She was a member of the First Methodist Church, a member of the Naomi Ruth Class and the Come By Here Circle of the Church. Ruth was a volunteer at the Hospital Gift Shop for over 30 years, she was active in the wing 9 hospital auxillary. She was also a member of the Guernsey County Retired Teachers Association, the Guernsey County Senior Citizens and was on the board for the Salvation Army.

Ruth was preceded in death by her parents; her husband Harrison O. Rose in 1990; a brother Boyd White; a sister-in-law Fern White and a stepson Marc Rose.

She leaves a son David Rose of Columbus.
