



Sarah Joan Lilienthal

March 23, 1928 - June 5, 2018

Longtime resident of Cambridge, Ohio, Joan Lilienthal died on June 5, 2018 at her home in Virginia at the age of 90. She was predeceased by her husband of 68 years, Bill, and two infant children; C. Wm. Jr., and Deborah Bess Lilienthal. Joan was born on March 23, 1928 in Cambridge; the only child of the late Charles Y. and Bessie G. (Beggs) Tribbie. She was blessed to have Iona Butler Tribbie as a stepmother. Most of her life was spent in Guernsey County until a few years ago when decreasing health forced her and Bill to move closer to their daughter Lisa. Joan was a member of Center United Methodist Church and later 9th Street United Methodist Church. She was a 1945 graduate of Cambridge High School (formally Brown High) where she was a member of the marching band. While in high school she was employed at the former Davis Department Store, and was a member of the Kappa Delta Phi Sorority. After graduation she worked in the lab at the Cambridge State Hospital and later held a part time position for a few years in the office of the Guernsey County Treasurer. In 1949 she married C. Wm. (Bill) Lilienthal and was later blessed with their only child, Lisa. She was active in the PTA at Park Elementary School and served as president for 2 years. She was instrumental in starting Girl Scout Troop #5 at Park and also served as co-leader for many years. She was a charter member of the Lioness Club of Cambridge. She was voted Lioness of the year in 1988 and was a past president of that club. She also delivered Meals-on-Wheels for many years. She loved to play bridge, along with 7 other ladies she was part of a group that met every other week

for more than 50 years. At the time they disbanded, she was one of three remaining original members of the club. After that she joined another group and that foursome played together for more than 10 years. She loved the Buckeyes and was able to attend a few games at the Shoe. She was also on hand for a number of championship games as well. In her opinion the greatest was the 1968-69 season and the Rose Bowl victory. During the time leading up to Memorial Day she would help Bill in placing American flags on the graves of our veterans in Northwood Cemetery and other cemeteries in Cambridge. In addition to her daughter and son-in-law Lisa and Jim Sheaks of Virginia, she leaves behind 2 granddaughters, Lori (Cory) Morewitz of Virginia and Erin (Ben) Cawley of North Carolina, 5 great grandchildren Corinne, Logan, and Colin Morewitz and Lincoln and Gavin Cawley, brother-in-law Bob Lilienthal, 3 nieces Mary Pat, Judy, and Cathy Lilienthal, and 2 nephews Rick (Marianne) and Rob (Debbie) Lilienthal, 3 very special cousins Betty Tremelling, Janet Andrews, and Linda Potts, and other cousins and dear friends.
