March 11, 1965 - April 4, 2022

Stacey Lynn Morrow, age 57 of Cambridge, passed away on Monday, April 4, 2022, at Genesis Hospital in Zanesville, Ohio. She was born in Cambridge on March 11, 1965, of John Charles Enos and Karen Louise (Bucey) Enos of Cambridge.

Mrs. Morrow was a registered nurse and had worked at Southeastern Ohio Regional Medical Center up until her disability. She married Dennis E. Morrow on April 26, 1997.
