Thomas M. Stevens, age 60 of Cambridge, passed away on Friday, September 11, 2015 at his home. He was born on June 10, 1955 to the late John Thomas Stevens and Marjorie (Bowers) Stevens - Siders of Hillsboro. Tom was a member of the 1st Presbyterian Church in Cambridge where he had also been a Deacon. He graduated Cambridge High School class of 1973. He was the owner of Guernsey Antiques and former owner of Dewey Avenue Market, Stevens Market in Quaker City, Stevens Market in Dresden, Stevens Market in Senecaville and the Eighth Street Dell in Cambridge.

Tom is survived by: his wife Cathy Folkert Stevens & special buddy Barlkey; his mother Marjorie (George) Siders; a brother Charles (Lynn) Stevens; cousin Terry (Janice) Scott; special cousin Libby Wiggington; brother-in-law Rick (Brenda) Folkert; nieces, Ashley Folkert and Kelsey Folkert; nephew Nicholas Folkert; and a great niece Addison Wentz.

Tom's passion in life was the antique world, which he was blessed with at a young age. He had the unique ability to understand a piece and know its composition and its history with in a few minutes of study. Tom and Cathy frequented the auction world through the region. Tom was devastated when his beloved antique building was destroyed by fire. With his Stevens constitution he rose like a phoenix and re- opened Guernsey Antiques in Norwich a short time later. He will indeed be missed.
