Thomas G. Tomplait, age 88 of Cambridge, passed away on Monday, September 3, 2018 at SEORMC. He was born on February 28, 1930 in Port Arthur, Texas, a son of the late Joseph V. Tomplait and Monterey Louise (King) Tomplait.

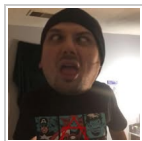
