Trinda Diane Gregory, age 76 of Cambridge, passed away on Sunday, December 21, 2025 at The Beckett House in New Concord. She was born on August 29, 1949 in Cambridge, the daughter of the late Galen “Skip” Braniger and Wilma “Jimmie” (Nichols) Braniger.

Mrs. Gregory was a 1967 graduate of John Glenn High School who then chose a career as a Fingerprint Technician for the FBI in Washington, DC.
