February 28, 1931 - March 14, 2010

Virginia Lee Riggs Todd, age 79 of Cambridge, passed away on Sunday, March 14, 2010 at Palms of Pasadena Hospital in St. Petersburg , FL. She was born on February 28, 1931 in Cameron W.VA., a daughter of the late Clarence Riggs and Margaret Slonaker Riggs.

Surviving are: her husband, William G. Todd of the home, they were married in 1956.; a sister, Deloris Melvin Lark of Toledo, Ohio; and a brother, Jerry Becky Riggs of Cameron, W.VA.

Mrs. Todd was a lifetime member of the Cameron Church of Christ and Cambridge Church of Christ. She graduated from Cameron High School in 1949, the Ohio Valley General Hospital 1951 with a degree in nursing. She then went on to attend Duke University and West Liberty State College, and later received a Bachelor of Science in 1959 from Ohio State University. She taught clinical and surgical nursing at Aultman Hospital in Canton and the Ohio Valley General Hospital in Wheeling.

Virginia worked at Ametek March Electric for 28 years. She began as an industrial nurse and later as director of human resources. She retired from March electric in 1987. After retirement she volunteered at Southeastern Ohio Regional Medical Center in Cambridge, where she accumulated more than 2000 hours.
