Virginia A. Mbiad, age 98 of Cambridge, passed away on Sunday, August 17, 2014 at the Morrison House in Zanesville. She was born on December 7, 1915 in Pennsborro, W.V., a daughter of the late Ellis Corra and Theba (Farris) Corra.

Mrs. Mbiad was a member of St. Benedict's Catholic Church. Her and her husband John were the owner operators of Virginia's Luncheonette on 4th St. in Cambridge. Following the death of her husband, she then went to work for Kennedy's Bakery for several years. She was a past officer of the Catholic Daughters of the Americas and was a past president of the St. Benedict's Catholic Women's Club for 14 years.
