William M. Moffett, age 91 of Cambridge, passed away on Sunday, September 29, 2019 at his home. He was born on October 13, 1927 in Cambridge, a son of the late Charles J. Moffett and Hazel M. (McBride) Moffett.

Mr. Moffett was a 1945 graduate of Cambridge High School. He served in the U. S. Army in the band from 1946 to 1947. Bill was a heavy equipment operator with Moffett Brothers Corporation.
