William G. Todd, age 90, of Cambridge, passed away on Friday, March 11, 2016 at Genesis Health Care. He was born on July 17, 1925 in Cameron, West Virginia, a son of the late John Todd and Lucy (Courtwright) Todd. Bill graduated Cameron High School before joining the U.S.Army. He served in World War II from 1943 to 1946 in the 17th Airborne and 82nd Airborne and was involved in three major battles; the Battle of The Bulge, The Airlift Over The Rhine and The Argone Forest. He was in Berlin for six months of occupation before being discharged. Bill, then went to work as a lineman for General Telephone. He worked there his entire career and retired as a supervisor. Bill was a member of the Church of Christ in Cambridge and in Cameron, West Virginia. He was also a member of the V.F.W. Post 2901. Bill is preceded in death by: his parents, John and Lucy Todd; his wife Virginia (Riggs) Todd whom passed away on March 14, 2010.

Surviving are: his sister-in-law Deloris (Melvin) Lark of Northwood; brother-in-law Jerry Riggs of Cameron W.V.; and cousins, including Marvin and Larry Tedrow.

Visitation will be at Bundy-Law Funeral Home Friday, March 18, 2016 from 11 am to 12 pm with a 12 pm service. Rev. John Keith will officiate the service.
