



## William S. Wycoff

October 3, 1942 - May 2, 2016

William S. "Bill" Wycoff, age 73 of Cambridge, passed away on Monday, May 2, 2016 from an accident near his home. He was born on October 3, 1942 in Rix Mills, son of the late Wayne M. Wycoff and Kathryn J. (Aitken) Wycoff. Bill was a 1961 graduate of New Concord High School. He served his country in the Armored Cavalry in the 7th Army during the Vietnam era in Germany. He attended College Drive Presbyterian Church in New Concord. Bill and his brother, Dal, were partners in Wycoff's Barbershop in Cambridge for over 46 years.

For over 30 years, he served as President of the Western Guernsey Water Company and for over 20 years has been a member of the Guernsey County Fair Board where he was the Concession Manager. He was also on the board of the Ohio River Valley Llama Association. He loved piddling in the barn and working with his llamas. Bill was an obstacle course engineer for llama shows all around the country.

Bill is survived by: his wife Phyllis A. (McKahan) Wycoff, they were married on November 25, 1989; his children, Christa (David) Selnick of Tiffin and Wayne D.
