



## Wilmer L. "Peewee" Winnett

November 16, 1927 - April 22, 2018

Wilmer L. "Peewee" Winnett, age 90 of Cambridge, passed away on Sunday, April 22, 2018 at his home. He was born on November 16, 1927 in Cambridge, a son of the late Lawrence G. Winnett and Edna L. (Moffatt) Winnett.

Mr. Winnett was a 1945 graduate of Cambridge High School. He then went to Muskingum College and played football for Ed Sherman. Peewee worked at Universal Pottery for a while before becoming a Union Carpenter. He had worked for many contractors including; Andy Smith, Walter Guegold and Harold Davis. He was a faithful attendee of Christ United Methodist Church. He was very athletic and played many sports. He was secretary in a senior golf league for 15 years, he had hit two Hole-In-One's, he played baseball and softball, and played tennis every Saturday morning with Shorty Williams. Peewee had also bowled a 300. He coached kids baseball and had also received a Patron Award from the Cambridge City Park. Peewee had built several houses by himself, including the one they call home.

Peewee is survived by: his wife of almost 68 years, Bonnie J. (Sigman) Winnett; their three sons, William Lawrence "Larry" (Jamie) Winnett of Smyrna, TN., Randy L.
